

ARTICLE III

SPOUSAL SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE

*3.1 Alimony. Husband is employed by the United Parcel Service as a feeder driver. He earns approximately \$77,000 per year. Wife is unemployed. The duration of the marriage was four and one half years, both parties are in good health.

Husband shall pay alimony in the amount of \$125 per week in limited duration alimony. Alimony shall terminate upon wife's remarriage, the death of either party, Wife's income increasing to more than \$50,000 per year or on December 31, 2012, whichever first occurs.

Alimony shall be tax deductible to Husband and shall be considered income to Wife as per the regulations of the Internal Revenue Service.

Child support shall be reviewed and the New Jersey Child Support Guidelines applied when alimony terminates.

3.2 Health Insurance. The parties agree that a limited divorce shall be entered and shall remain in place until at least JANUARY 1, 2013 (2013) ~~December 31, 2012~~. Wife shall remain on Husband's insurance coverage during this period.

In the event Husband converts the judgment of divorce prior to 11/1/2013 ~~December 31, 2012~~, he shall cover 75% of the monthly cost of Wife obtaining a health insurance policy comparable to the one she currently uses.

Upon the conversion of the divorce from a limited to final divorce, each shall obtain and provide for their own health insurance coverage. The parties further agree to pay and be responsible for the payment of their own health insurance premiums in this regard.

* LUMP SUM - \$20,000 + (actual counsel fees of W or \$7500, whichever is less). Same to be put into annuity and payable at \$100/wk until paid. H is not obligated for W's legal fees.
